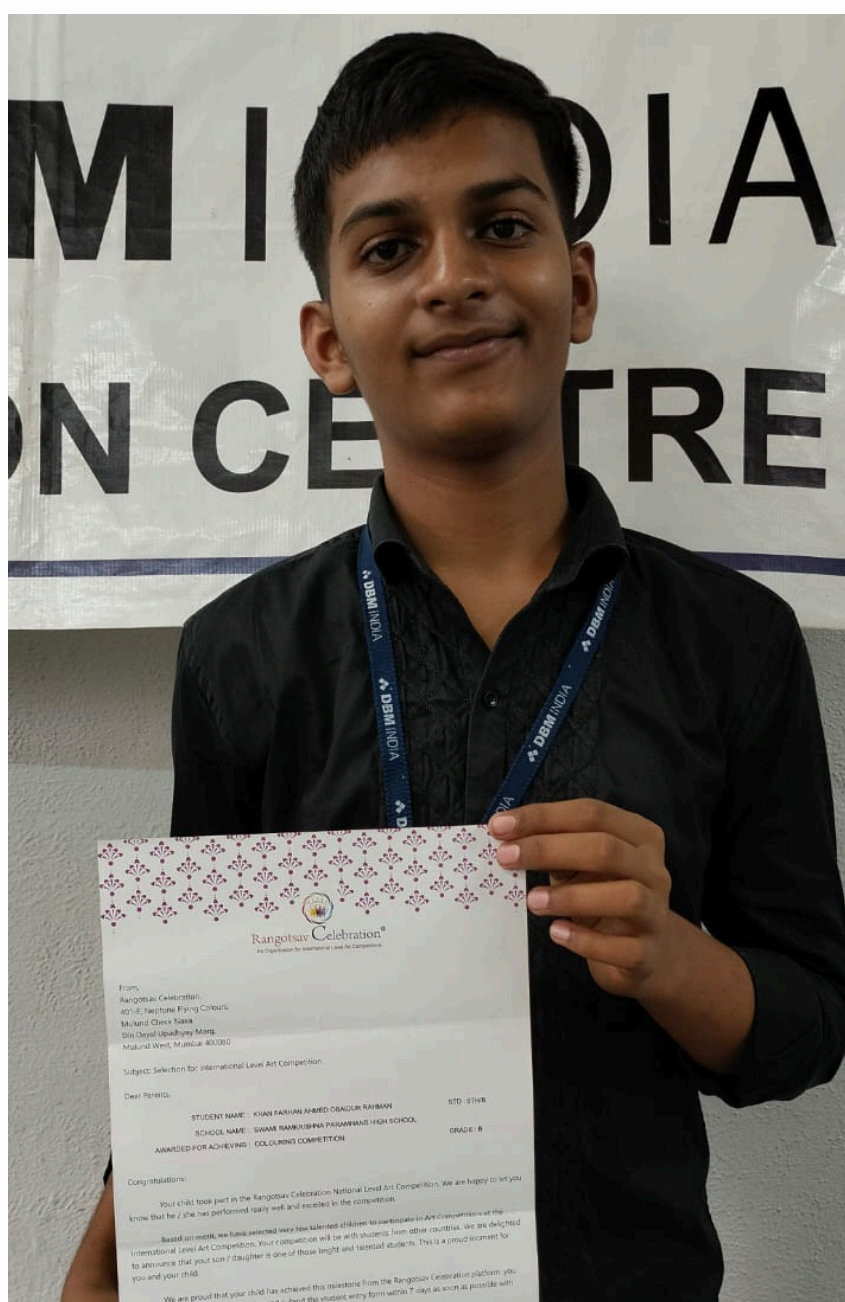

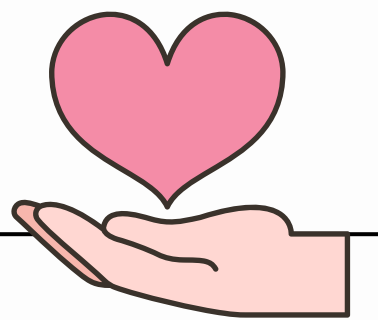
## Inauguration of Hospitality batch- Chembur
