After completing the course with DBM India she worked hard and now has opened her own pre-primary school.

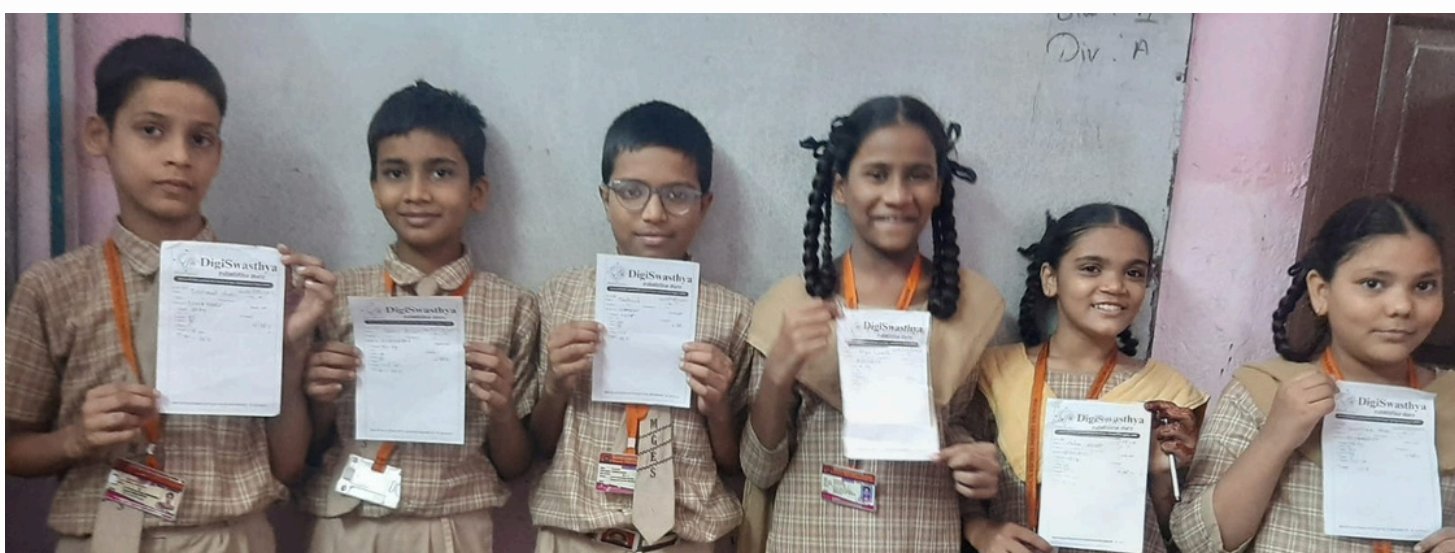

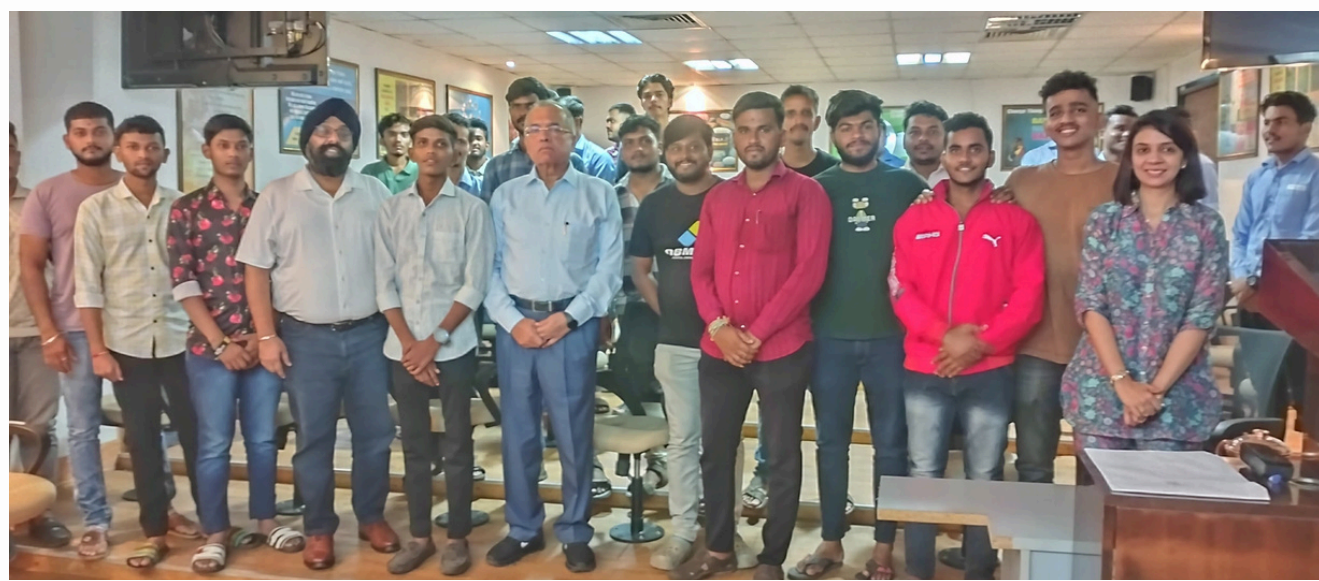


Bhiwandi Certificate Distribution and Inauguration

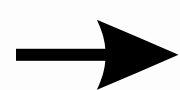
The session aimed to equip students with practical knowledge to make informed financial decisions and manage personal finances effectively.
